Organization and Function

MISSION AND MAJOR FUNCTIONS OF  
THE TOOELE ARMY DEPOT (TEAD)

---

Applicability. This regulation applies to TEAD, a subordinate installation of the U.S. Army Operations Support Command (OSC) and the U.S. Army Munitions and Armaments Command (MAC).

Decentralized printing. All OSC installations may locally reproduce this regulation.

Supplementation. Persons who wish to supplement this regulation and establish a local form must obtain prior approval from the proponent.

1. Purpose. This regulation sets forth the mission and major functions of TEAD and assigns responsibility and delegates authority to the Commander for the accomplishment of assigned missions.

2. Mission. There are two main missions at TEAD: Ammunition Operations and Ammunition Equipment Design and Development. The TEAD is the Army's Western Region Tier I ammunition depot. As a Tier I depot, TEAD receives, stores, issues, renovates, modifies, maintains and destroys conventional munitions for all Department of Defense (DOD) services. The TEAD provides base support to the activities and tenants on-site.

3. Major Functions.

a. Serves as the Western Tier I ammunition depot. Provides services to receive, store, issue, renovate, modify, maintain and destroy conventional ammunition for all DOD services.

b. Provides specialized services in the areas of ammunition equipment prototype design and development for conventional and chemical ammunition. To conceive, design, develop, manufacture, procure, rebuild, maintain and store test equipment including Ammunition Peculiar Equipment for use in demilitarization, renovation, modification, modernization, and normal maintenance of chemical and conventional-type ammunition. Develops robotics and remote control systems for use in military applications.

c. Provides base operations support to tenant activities.

4. Relationships. TEAD is under the command jurisdiction of the OSC Commanding General (CG). The CG assigns the Commanding Officer, TEAD, responsibility and authority to exercise command jurisdiction over the installation IAW the mission assigned. TEAD, its tenants, and other Government services/activities provide and receive administrative and logistical support IAW negotiated agreements.

5. Materiel Assignments.

a. The TEAD provides depot level maintenance on the Army defense conventional ammunition. TEAD is responsible for planning, organizing, directing, coordinating, and controlling multiple functions relating to the maintenance of rockets, mortars, grenades, mines, projectiles, demolition materials and smoke pots.

b. Special tools, tool sets, and test, measurement, and diagnostic equipment, which are a part of, or used with, assigned items.

c. Other equipment/materiel as assigned.
