MEMORANDUM FOR: (1) New US Army Sustainment Command (ASC) Worldwide Deployable DAC CENTCOM Position Applicant and (2) Examining Physician, PA or FNP

SUBJECT: ASC Policy for List of Physical Examination (PE) Requirements for ASC Worldwide Deployable Candidates to CENTCOM AOR

1. Scope: This is applicable to all DAC Applicants for ASC Deployable CENTCOM Positions and Examining Physician, PA or FNP
2. To applicant: We are pleased that you are applying for a CENTCOM deployable position with the US Army Sustainment Command (ASC). To expedite the approval of your physical exam by the ASC Surgeon, the following information is required from you and your examining healthcare provider (HCP).
 - a. You must complete specified sections of a DD Form 2807-1 (encl 1) and include a list of all current medical conditions and those within the past 10 years and list of all current medications and dosages. **All information provided is subject to verification of information from your personal physician (upon your approval) or through DOD and U.S. VA electronic medical database cross checks.**
 - b. You must complete specified sections of a DD Form 2808 and a SF 78 (encl 2 & 3). **The majority of sections on this form are to be completed by the examining health care provider.**
 - c. Required completed forms, lab tests, special test/procedures, and required immunizations are listed on enclosure 4; please use the checklist which matches your age and gender category. All items with the exception of immunizations must be completed prior to start of actual duties and initialed-off on the checklist (encl 4) by you and your examining physician before a physical can be reviewed by **ASC Surgeon (the Certifying Physician)**.
 - d. Incomplete DD and SF forms and incomplete checklists will not be reviewed by Certifying Medical Officer and will be returned to **Applicant** for completion and will delay your hiring process!!
 - e. If an item cannot be performed by your examing HCP, applicant and/or hiring agency is responsible for obtaining item, per hiring agency guidance.
 - f. All required items cannot be more than 9 months olds at time of examination, unless specifically stated on checklist.

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g. A HCP-signed copy of completed SF 78, DD 2807-1, DD 2808, Copy of lab reports (no hand written lab reports), HCP-initialed copy of all special test reports, and immunizations will be submitted to hiring agency personnel officer for submission to ASC Surgeon for review and certification. Please fax to 309-782-0289 or email completed PE packet to rock-asc-medical@conus.army.mil.

3. To examining HCP: Please ensure that DD 2807-1, 2808, SF 78, all items on checklist, and checklist are completed and initialed off to prevent delays in the medical certification process. All items with the exception of immunizations must be completed prior to start of actual duties and initialed-off on the checklist (encl 4) by applicant and your examining physician before a physical can be reviewed by **ASC Surgeon (the Certifying Physician)**.

a. Incomplete PE packets and checklists will be returned to applicant for corrective action.

b. These requirements are subject to change depending on CENTCOM policy.

c. The U.S. Army Sustainment Command (ASC) CENTCOM Preplacement PE's are subject to ASC Command Surgeon Certification.

d. Please note: ****Examining HCP is not the Certifying Agency Physician****; ASC Surgeon is Certifying Agency Physician.

e. Most required items cannot be more than nine months olds at time of examination, unless specifically stated on checklist.

f. A HCP-signed copy of completed SF 78, DD 2807-1, DD 2808, copy of lab reports (no hand written lab reports will be accepted), HCP-initialed copy of all special test reports, and immunizations will be submitted to hiring agency personnel officer for submission to ASC Surgeon for review and certification.
